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### -Using This Booklet-

- 1 In principle, industrial categories in this booklet follow the categories of the Japan Standard Industry Classification (JSIC)(12th edition), excluding those industries otherwise noted. Those industries classified in accordance with the 11th revision are denoted with "former industrial classification". Medium classifications and minor classifications, etc. are shown based on Japan Standard Industry Classification.
- 2 As a general rule, data taken from "Establishment and Enterprise Census" and "Economic Census for Business Frame" has been provided by private business establishments unless denoted otherwise.
- 3 The organization names noted as sources for data in this booklet are the names of the organizations at the time of the data release.
- 4 Unless otherwise noted, all figures in the graph apply to Tokyo.
- 5 "Industry in Tokyo" indicates the number of establishments and employees by industry by using mainly the "Establishment and Enterprise Census" (executed up to 2006) and the "Economic Census for Business Frame" (executed in 2009). The Economic Census employs survey techniques that differ from those used in the previously conducted Establishment and Enterprise Census of Japan. Therefore, some considerations would be required, when you compare the Economic Census with the Establishment and Enterprise Census of Japan.
  - The use of administrative records such as commercial registration , etc.
  - In head offices, etc. of establishments such as companies (excluding foreign companies), corporations other than companies and individual proprietorships, a method in which a business owner of the head office, etc. reports the data of all other branch offices relating to the head office, has been introduced.
- 6 Japan's Fiscal Year begins on April 1 and concludes on March 31 of the following year.
